## California Transportation & Logistics Institute Receives \$50,000 from Bank of America

**Los Angeles**— The California Transportation & Logistics Institute (CaTLI), a 501 (c) (3) nonprofit subsidiary of the Los Angeles County Economic Development Corporation (LAEDC), today received \$50,000 from the Bank of America Foundation to fund its mission and programs.
